Do you know the rules for your mobility scooter?

Pedestrian road rules apply to mobility scooter riders, however:

- You must not have a Blood Alcohol Concentration (BAC) Level over 0.05
- Your mobility scooter must not be able to travel faster than 10km/h
- Your mobility scooter must not carry more than one person

Before you ride:

- Seek the advice of your GP to assess the impact your health may have on your driving ability
- Make sure to purchase the right model of mobility scooter suited to your use, ability and weight distribution

Travel safely by:

- Give way for pedestrians
- Always look out when crossing driveways
- Slowing down when turning
- Riding at walking speed
