ATTENTION COMMERCIAL BUILDING OWNERS:

Owners of commercial buildings are reminded of their legal responsibilities to ensure the safety of building occupants & the broader community. Under the Environmental Planning & Assessment Regulation 2021, you are required to:

1. Maintain all essential (statutory) fire safety measures within your building at all times; &

2. Submit an Annual Fire Safety Statement (AFSS) to Council every year.

This statement must be accompanied by an assessment from an Accredited Practitioner (Fire Safety). A copy of the AFSS must also be provided to Fire & Rescue NSW. For further details on fire safety requirements, please refer to the following:

1. Ensure all fire safety measures are in working order.

2. Engage an Accredited Practitioner (Fire Safety) for inspection & assessment.

3. Lodge your Annual Fire Safety Statement with Council & provide a copy to Fire & Rescue NSW.
