Owners of commercial buildings are reminded to ensure the safety of building occupants & the broader community. Under the Environmental Planning & Assessment Regulation 2021, you are required to:

- 1. Maintain all essential (statutory) fire safety measures within your building at all times; &**
- 2. Submit an Annual Fire Safety Statement (AFSS) to Council every year.** This statement must be accompanied by an assessment from an Accredited Practitioner (Fire Safety). A copy of the AFSS must also be provided to Fire & Rescue NSW.
