Stay safe when walking by wearing bright, light-coloured & **reflective or fluoro clothing** so motorists can see you.

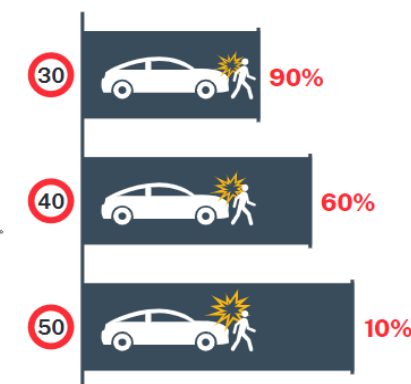
Take out your earphones & **put your phone away before crossing the road**.
