IS YOUR PET MICROCHIPPED WITH HOMESAFEID?

Residents who have had pets microchipped in the ACT or other states should check with vets. A major registration provider has stopped operations. **For NSW pet owners there is no significant impact as NSW uses the NSW Pet Registry as the official database.**

COMPANION ANIMAL REGISTRY AUDIT 2025:

CGRC Rangers are working on updating the NSW Companion Animal Register for 2025. Cat & dog owners are required under the NSW Companion Animals Act 1998 to ensure their animals are identified (microchipped) & registered. **Microchipping is not the same as registration.**

Pet registration is important as owners are complying with the law but also contributing to a safety & a more pet friendly community. Registered pets are more easily identified if they are lost & the funds collected from registration fees are put towards community facilities & animal welfare services.

Community members may receive a letter in the upcoming month regarding this audit.

The letter may request that they microchip & register their companion animals, or they will need to notify Council if an animal is no longer at the property or of any changed details. Registration can be paid at the CGRC Administration offices.

PEDESTRIAN SAFETY:

Are you walking during the early morning, or evening? Stay safe when walking by **wearing bright, light-coloured & reflective or fluoro clothing so motorists can see you.**

Take out your earphones & put your phone away before crossing the road.

Use a pedestrian crossing if there is one within 20 metres.

Walk on the footpath or nature strip.

If you do have to walk on the road without a footpath or nature strip, **stay as far to the side of the road as possible** facing oncoming traffic.

EULONGA QUARRY – EXHIBITION PERIOD EXTENDED TO COB 16 JUNE 2025:

A development application has been lodged with CGRC for the property at 809 Gobarralong Road, Coolac also identified as 338 Darbalara Road, Coolac.
Use of the land & establishment of a new extraction area for the purposes of an extractive industry (sand quarry) within Lot 158 DP 750984 and Lot 4 DP 1096529, to be operated in conjunction with the existing quarry (Eulonga Quarry) on Lot 1 DP 1096529 and Lot 2 DP 1096529. The development application, including plans and accompanying documents such as the Environmental Impact Statement is available on The NSW Planning Portal at: www.planningportal.nsw.gov.au/daex/exhibition/eulonga-quarry-proposed-new-extraction-area
